# FRIDAY TRASH PICKUP THANKSGIVING WEEK

Normally, trash pickup in Old Mill is on Monday and Thursday. However, on the week of Thanksgiving, pickup day is on Friday. No other holidays will change trash pickup dates this Fall or this coming Winter.

As a reminder, containers with bagged trash, recycling bins and other items for disposal must be put at the designated trash areas after dusk the day before pickup day.

#### RESIDENT AND VISITOR PARKING

As you already know, each house in our community has two assigned permanent parking spaces. We also have visitor's parking spaces scattered throughout the community.

The designated visitor parking spaces shall not be used regularly to park any vehicle. A vehicle shall not park in the visitor's parking for more than 48 hours within any 30 day period. Vehicles in violation of this community rules may be tagged with an orange warning violation sticker, or may be towed.

# RECYCLING IN OLD MILL COMMUNITY

Recycling is the process of collecting and processing materials that would otherwise be thrown away as trash and turning them into new products. Recycling benefits our community and the environment by conserving resources and energy, decreasing pollution, and creating jobs.

#### CURBSIDE RECYCLING

The materials collected curbside in our area are listed below. All materials can be put in the same recycling bin (not in a bag), and they should be clean and dry. If a material cannot be cleaned (for example a greasy pizza



box) it cannot be recycled. In Old Mill Community, recyclable materials are picked up on Mondays with the regular trash pickup.

- Newspaper
- Office paper and envelopes
- Junk mail
- Brochures and magazines
- File folders
- Poster board
- Cardboard boxes
- Milk and juice cartons
- Thick plastic bottles and jugs
- Metal food and beverage cans

# GLASS RECYCLING

Fairfax County collects glass for recycling in purple bins at several locations around the county. The closest location to Old Mill is the Springfield District Governmental Center at 6140 Rolling Road.



# HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Household hazardous waste refers to used or leftover materials with one of the four characteristics of a hazardous waste: toxicity, ignitability, corrosivity or reactivity. These should not be disposed of with the



regular trash. The Fairfax County Household Hazardous Waste Program accepts hazardous materials from residents free of charge and disposes or recycles them according to all local, state and federal regulations (info line 703-324-5068). The closest location to us is the I-66 Transfer Station (4618 West Ox Road, Fairfax) which operates 7 days per week from 7 am to 4 pm except some holidays. Here are some examples of common household hazardous waste:

- Chemicals like acetone and acids
- Aerosols (spray cans)
- Ammonia and bleach products
- Automotive fluids
- Batteries
- e-Cigarettes
- Fluorescent Lamps, Unbroken
- Gasoline
- Gas cylinders
- Light-Emitting Diode (LED) bulbs
- Mercury products, thermometers, and thermostats
- Nail Polish and nail polish remover
- Pharmaceuticals
- Paint and paint thinner
- Pesticides and poisons
- Polishes
- Varnish and wood preservatives
